

Information from compulsory school management about Covid-19 and infection tracing

The spread of Covid-19 is now extensive and is noticeable in our schools. Previously, it has been the responsibility of the principals to provide information about new cases within the school, in a class or individual year. The purpose has been to make parents/guardians aware of the increased risk of infection.

As infection is now so widespread, from today the 27th January 2022, the principals will no longer provide information of new cases of Covid-19 in the school, class or year. The decision for this change has been taken after consultation with Region Uppsala's infection control.

As a parent/guardian, you need to assume that your child/children can be in an environment where they are exposed to infection and, as usual, be observant for symptoms.

We are still following-up all confirmed cases in our establishments, so please continue to inform the school if your child has Covid-19. By confirmed, we mean a positive test result from either an antigen test (so called Rapid Test) or PCR-test.
